Club of Rome 2004 Annual Conference

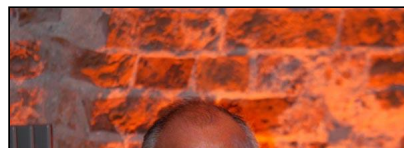
